

Are you unable to accept a job opportunity because you can't get there?

If you live in East Staffordshire, Staffordshire Moorlands or Newcastle Borough (excluding Stoke-on-Trent) we may be able to help you.

The **Wheels to Work Scheme** is part of the **Staffordshire Rural Access to Services Partnership** funded by Advantage West Midlands and managed by Staffordshire County Council.

The **Staffordshire Wheels to Work** scheme (excluding Stoke-on-Trent and Tamworth) offers mopeds, bicycles, driving lessons, travel vouchers and vehicle repair grants. All are available to anyone over the age of 16years (no upper restrictions) who are unable to accept a job offer because access is a barrier.

Applicants must have a job offer or vocational training course in place before they will be considered. The turnaround on applications for mopeds is two weeks and the mopeds are available for approximately six months. This gives the client time to make alternative arrangements whilst earning.
